Sunday September 25

Century Ride

Hawaii Bicycling League's Century Ride takes place on Sunday, September 25, 2022, starting at 6:15 a.m. from Kapi'olani Park. The ride goes through Hawai'i Kai and directly past PHK. An aid station at JAAMS will be open from 8:00am to 4:00pm. Watch out for cyclists!

Fire Safety

Residents are encouraged to be prepared. Become familiar with the location of the fire alarm

pull station nearest your unit, and know the shortest route to the exit stairway (in case of a fire, do not use the elevators).

In the event of a fire, residents should pull the fire alarm and call 911. Like most high-rise residential buildings on Oahu, the PHK fire alarms are not directly linked to the Fire Department.
