#### Reminders

A number of residents have asked that the following reminders be included in the newsletter.

#### Noise:

Shutting the walkway's lower louver windows helps prevent inside conversations, music, and noise from echoing off the walkway walls, giving you more privacy.

#### **Drains:**

Cooking grease causes clogs when poured down the drain.

Drain screens prevent hair and other items from forming clogs, as well.

## Exercise room:

Please put equipment back in its place, turn off the lights, fan and radio when pau with your exercising.

### **Trash Chute Problems**

Any liquids, especially paint and flammable liquids should never be dropped down the trash

chute, even if they are inside a can or bottle. Bring them down to the trash room to discard. Make sure your repair workers are aware of this. Boxes should be broken down and taken to trash room also.

#### **Pigeon Problems**

Many of our residents are having problems with pigeons on our lanai and window sills.

Our condo, like many other condos, are presently exploring ways to prevent these birds from landing and building nests. There are many preventive means that can be used and some of these ideas will soon be posted in each floor's new notice rack.
